It has been a busy and productive first few weeks of Term 4 here at Annunciation. As part of our Term 4 Design and Technology Unit, the F/1 students have been journeying through the wonders of Ancient Egypt. After learning about the importance of the Nile River, the class took their learning outdoors for a hands-on challenge.

Working in pairs, students were tasked with designing their own miniature Nile River.

They were given tinfoil to mold into a long, narrow trough- wide enough to accommodate small to medium-sized toys and rocks. Armed with watering cans, they poured water through their creations, experimenting with flow speed, volume, and terrain placement in the sandpit.

This activity not only reinforced their understanding of how rivers shape landscapes, but also encouraged creativity, collaboration, and engineering thinking. We're excited to continue building on this momentum as the term progresses and see where our curiosity leads us next.











GARDENING CLUB- SPRING HARVEST!

Last week, the students got to harvest all the remaining winter veggies in the school garden. Handfuls of rainbow chard, beetroot and lettuce were taken home in paper bags.






CHESS CLUB

Well done to Jonathan and River for creating the club for the students and running it each week.










AUSTRALIAN SCHOOL OF PERFORMING ARTS AUSTRALIAN GIRLS CHOIR OPEN DAY




