### **SWIMMING PROGRAM: F-2 STUDENTS**



Students in Years Foundation to 2 will participate in an 6-week Swimming Program at Paul Sadler Swimland Westgate, 61-69 Dohertys Road, Altona North commencing on Wednesday 8th October (Term 4, Week 1).

The compulsory program, consisting of a 45-minute lesson each week will focus on Water Safety and Stroke Development.

On swimming days, children are to wear their SPORT UNIFORM with their bathers underneath. They should bring a separate bag containing a towel, underwear, brush/comb, thongs/sandals, goggles (optional), swimming cap (optional) and a plastic bag for wet items.


