SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDER

nForma Connect

At Annunciation, our aim is to continually streamline our school communication and practices, and we thank you for your continued support as we embrace these new procedures.

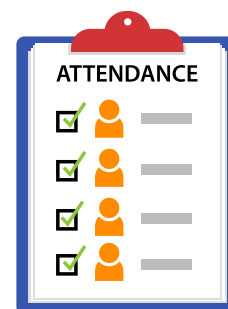
First Aid...COMING SOON!

As part of the nForma app, we now have the capability to inform families instantly when their child has attended sick bay. Moving forward, we will be rolling out this First Aid function. When your child visits the sick bay here at school, you will receive an automatic notification and email alerting you to the visit.

Please note that for serious injuries, or if your child needs to be collected from school, the office will still phone you directly.

Attendance

We are pleased to announce that families can now use the **nForma Connect app** to log student absences. If your child is going to be away, simply enter the details directly into the app ahead of time.



Please ensure you use **nForma Connect** rather than **Audiri** so that your notification reaches our office instantly. As part of our commitment to streamline our practices, we are phasing out Audiri and will move exclusively to nForma Connect later this year.

When logging an absence, you will be prompted to select one of the following reasons:

- **Accident / Transport Issues**
- **Bereavement**
- **Extended Family Holiday**
- **Family (Parent Choice)**
- **Hospitalised**
- **Medical Appointment**
- **Refusal**
- **Religious / Cultural Observance**
- **Sick / Health / Medical**

Using this feature greatly streamlines our administrative processes. It reduces the need for you to ring the school office or send separate emails, saving you time and ensuring our records are instantly updated.

Please note that to ensure the safety of all students, our system will now send an automatic SMS alert at 9:30am if your child is marked **absent without an explanation**. Logging your child's absence early via the app will prevent you from receiving this alert.

BOOK WEEK

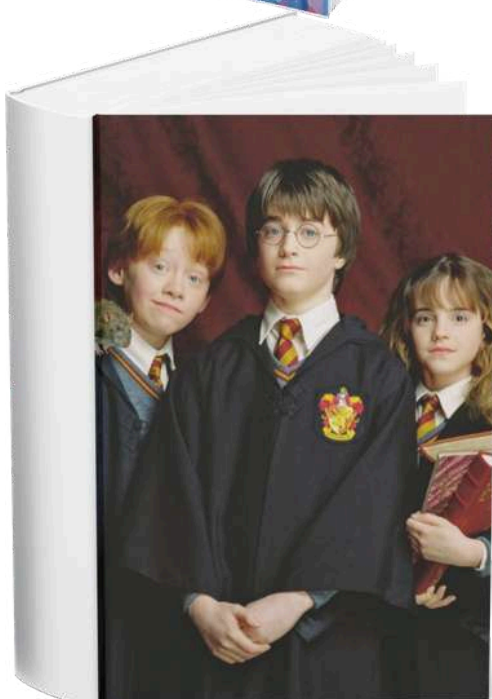

FRV Lithium-ion Battery Safety – Schools Stakeholder Kit



As the school year continues, many students are using devices such as laptops, tablets, phones, e-bikes and e-scooters. Most of these devices contain lithium-ion batteries, which have become part of everyday life, but need to be used safely.

Fire services are responding to an increasing number of fires caused by lithium-ion batteries, often caused by incorrect charging or leaving devices unattended. That's why fire safety at home is especially important during the school year.

You can help reduce the risk by:

- Only using the charger and battery designed for each device
- Unplugging devices once fully charged
- Never charging devices on soft surfaces like beds or couches
- Not charging devices overnight, or when no one is home
- Charging larger devices such as e-bikes and e-scooters away from living spaces and keeping them clear of exits
- Regularly checking devices and stopping use if a battery looks damaged, swollen or overheats

It's also important to make sure smoke alarms are working and tested every month. Fire Rescue Victoria recommends installing smoke alarms in bedrooms, living rooms and near areas where devices are charged—because working smoke alarms save lives.
