REFLECTION

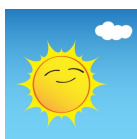
The Lord gave them bread from heaven—Psalm 77(78):3-4, 23-25, 54.

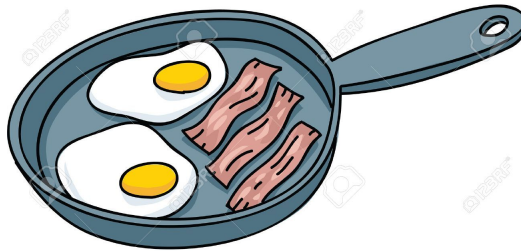

FATHER'S DAY BREAKFAST

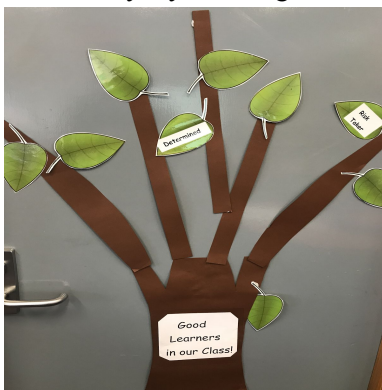
