Staff will ensure that all out of hours school events are child safe and comply with the Child safety Standards

- staff be flexible with programs and timetabling
- all staff continue to develop an awareness in curriculum initiatives and policy through professional development
- all staff are committed to the importance of parent participation; that we work in partnership with parents by supporting and attending out-of-school hours activities
- all staff present a professional image in all aspects of school life
- all staff maintain a safe work environment supporting OH&S legislation
- all staff are aware of School Policies and curriculum documents (Annunciation Primary School, CEM and CECV) and implement them as required
- all staff continue to develop an awareness in curriculum initiatives and policy through professional development
