PRINCIPAL'S REFLECTION

Tucked away in the quiet hills above Ephesus, the House of Mary was a place of deep stillness and reverence. Surrounded by olive trees, fragrant air, and the gentle sounds of nature, it wasn't hard to imagine Mary finding peace here after a life shaped by faith, courage, sorrow, and grace. The simplicity of the stone house, believed by many to be her final earthly home, created a powerful sense of presence—as though the walls themselves had absorbed generations of prayer.

As we entered, there was a natural quiet among our group, each person drawn into their own reflection. During our shared time of prayer, I felt a deep sense of connection—not only to Mary, but also to the others around me, to those who had come before us, and to all those for whom we were praying.

One of the most moving moments was visiting the nearby wall of intentions. Each of us wrote our own prayer and tied it to the wall, adding to the sea of white ribbons that fluttered gently in the breeze. These simple pieces of paper and fabric represented the hopes, sorrows, and faith of countless pilgrims. It was a beautiful and tangible way to unite our journey with Mary, and with the prayers of people from all corners of the world.

Standing there, in that sacred space, I was reminded of how powerfully Mary's quiet strength continues to speak to us—offering comfort, encouragement, and peace. It felt especially meaningful to be there so close to Mother's Day, honouring Mary not only as the Mother of Jesus, but as a mother to us all.

They specialise in working with children, offering services such as check-ups, cleans, and more—right here at the School! The team is specially trained to provide compassionate and tailored care for neurodiverse patients, ensuring a respectful and supportive experience for everyone.

Early dental visits are crucial for your child's long-term oral health. At this visit, Teeth On Wheels will help identify and address common dental concerns, such as:

- · Thumb-sucking- which can affect tooth development.
- Teeth eruption- ensuring teeth are coming through correctly.
- Bite issues preventing misalignments that may cause future problems.
- Hypoplasia- weakened tooth enamel that can lead to decay.
- Decay and cavities catching early signs before they develop into bigger issues.
- Deep grooves and pits- which can trap food and bacteria, increasing the risk of decay.
- Gum infections- preventing long-term damage to gums and surrounding tissue.

If eligible under the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS), your child may even receive FREE dental care.
