
Feast of St. Mary of the Cross MacKillop - 8th August

Mary MacKillop was born in Melbourne in 1842 and died in Sydney on 8th August 1909. She took the religious name Mary of the Cross. Responding to the isolation of colonial families, she pioneered a new form of religious life to provide education for their children. She and her sisters shared the life of the poor and the itinerant, offering special care to destitute women and children.

Remembered for her eagerness to discover God's will in all things, for her charity in the face of calumny, and for her abiding trust in God's providence.

Mary Mackillop was declared a Saint by Pope Benedict XVI on the 17th October 2010. In January 2013, St Mary of the Cross was declared as the Second Patron Saint of Australia.

This means that Australia now has two Patron Saints: Mary Help of Christians and St. Mary of the Cross MacKillop.
