# **SCHOOL FEES STATEMENTS**

## **CERES EXCURSION - Monday 19th February**

The students will travel to CERES by bus, which will depart from the school at 9.15am sharp. Therefore, they must be at school by 8.45am. Students will return by bus, arriving back at school at approximately 3pm.



Students should wear their sports uniform, and their school hat. They should also bring a small backpack to hold their recess and lunch snacks, as well as a water bottle.

They do not need to bring their school bags.

# REMINDER RE: CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card for the 2024 year, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The allowance amount for primary aged children is \$150.00 per year.

Applications for the CSEF can be collected from the school office. We encourage families to submit these to the school office as soon as possible.

**HOW TO APPLY:** New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef. If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2023, you do not need to complete an application form in 2024, **unless** there has been a change in your family circumstances. You only need to complete an application form (AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OFFICE) if any of the following changes have occurred:

new student enrolments;

- ❖ your child has started or changed schools in 2024 or you did not apply in 2023.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number,
- or new siblings commencing at the school in 2024.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.


