### WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS: EVERY DAY COUNTS

Regular school attendance is one of the most important factors in a child's learning and long-term success. Research shows that even a few days off can have a measurable impact on a child's progress—especially in subjects like reading and maths, where learning builds day by day. For example, children who miss just 8 days of school can fall behind their peers by several places in test rankings. Missing 10 or more days in a school year significantly lowers the chance of reaching expected standards by the end of primary school. These effects are not just short-term—chronic absence is linked to lower achievement in secondary school and beyond. By attending school every day, children stay on track, build confidence, and are better prepared for future learning. Every day really does count!

We ask parents and carers to think carefully about the impact that multiple days of absence can have on their child's learning and development. Of course, we understand that children do get sick from time to time, and we do not expect unwell children to attend school. However, where possible, consistent attendance supports the best outcomes for your child—now and in the future.


