

### **SEESAW**

We are relaunching the SEESAW APP next week. SEESAW is an app that parents can put on their phone and teachers and students can send photos/videos etc of work completed by your child. For example your child might have completed a Maths problem and they may send a photo of how they did this. This then provides a great opportunity for you to have a conversation about the learning happening at school. We used SEESAW for remote learning and now we wish to use it to provide on the spot feedback to you as the parents. In the Junior school the teachers will need to upload the photos whereas the older children will be able to choose what they would like to share and then upload themselves. As a result there may be different amounts of notices that you may receive class to class. Eventually we hope that all the children will be experts in SEESAW and will be able to select and upload whenever they wish. Codes will be sent home soon so that you can download the APP.

#### SCHOOL VEGETABLE GARDEN

We have started a school vegetable garden. The idea is that each term a grade will help plant vegetables and then help to maintain the garden over the coming weeks.

Children will be able to harvest their vegetables. If you would like to assist please send an email to your classroom teacher. It will simply be helping the children to weed and just checking the water levels etc. **The first Grade to do the garden will be Grade 3/4.** If you would like to assist grade 3/4 in planting we will be planting next Thursday at 2:30pm. As I have had many offers of assistance, perhaps parents from Grade 3/4 can be involved first.



### ENHANCING CATHOLIC SCHOOL IDENTITY SURVEY

# CAMP, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card for the 2022 year, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The allowance amount for primary aged children is \$125.00 per year.

Appplications for the CSEF can be collected from the school office. We encourage families to submit these to the school office as soon as possible.
