Building Strong Relationships at Annunciation Primary School



On Thursday 28 August, all staff at Annunciation Primary School attended the second training day in the Berry Street Education Model. The main focus of this training day was about Relationships and the importance of experiencing and nurturing positive relationships in our daily lives.

At Annunciation Primary School, we know that positive relationships are at the heart of every child's learning and wellbeing. That's why we have begun using the Berry Street Education Model (BSEM) to guide how we support students each day.

The Relationships domain of BSEM focuses on helping children feel safe, connected and respected. When children know that their teachers and peers care about them, they are more willing to learn, try new things and persist when challenges arise.

Some of the ways we strengthen relationships at Annunciation include:

- Warm connections greeting students by name, showing genuine interest in their lives and celebrating their efforts.
- Trust and respect modelling kindness, fairness and consistency so children feel secure and valued.
- Belonging and teamwork encouraging students to work together, listen to each other and appreciate everyone's unique gifts.
- Restorative practices helping students repair relationships when conflicts occur, so they learn empathy, responsibility and forgiveness.

By focusing on strong, respectful relationships, we are helping your child to not only succeed in their learning but also to grow into a compassionate and confident person.
