SPORTS UNIFORM - Boys and Girls

- Maroon sports shorts
- Short sleeve, light blue polo shirt with school logo
- School maroon tracksuit consisting of double-knee track pants (no stripes) and either a windcheater with school logo or a bomber jacket with school logo
- White socks
- Sport shoes (runners)
- Maroon hair ties/scrunchies (Girls)

Sports Uniform may only be worn on the designated sports day unless otherwise advised by teachers.

Parents are also reminded of the need for appropriate footwear (runners) for sport that will offer the child support during the Physical Education program. Slip on runners, platform sole runners or runners with a low-cut back (heel) do not offer appropriate support during exercise.

ALL CLOTHING NEEDS TO BE CLEARLY MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION

Children should be taught to recognize their own name inside their clothing. They are responsible for their own belongings.

JEWELLERY

1. Earrings- Students may wear a single plain sleeper or plain stud in each earlobe. No other body piercing is permitted.

- 2. Neck Chains- may only be worn underneath clothing ie. they must not be visible.
- 3. Watches- excluding novelty watches may be worn to school.
- 4. Finger nail polish, make-up, rings, bracelets and other jewellery are not to be worn to school.
- 5. The wearing of other fashion accessories is not permitted. Eg. glitter

If a breach of the policy occurs, the Principal or Deputy Principal will confiscate the items and parents may collect them from the school.

HAIR GROOMING

- 1. Hair longer than shoulder length should be well groomed and must be tied back with appropriate maroon coloured plain scrunchies, hair clips or headbands.
- 2. Hair must be a student's 'natural' colour only.
- 3. Hairstyles should reflect a "moderate and neat" image as appropriate for school life, therefore radical or extreme haircuts and are not acceptable. It will be at the Principal's discretion to decide if a haircut is acceptable or non-acceptable.

ACCESSORIES

Mobile Phones- Children are not permitted to have mobile phones on school premises. Mobile phones are not needed and are an unnecessary distraction as well as a social pressure on other children.

Students who choose not to comply with uniform and grooming standards will be making a choice not to adhere to school rules. Parents will be notified and asked to meet with the Principal to resolve the issue.

BUYING SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Annunciation School Uniforms are available through the school office from Connie. The school sells the entire school uniform: polo shirts, trousers, grey shorts, sports shorts, trackpants, bomber jackets, windcheaters, bags and hats. Orders may be placed by obtaining an order form from the school office. Please send correct money to school in an envelope with the order form.

HAT POLICY

- Hats are to be worn by all students while outside during Terms 1 and 4.
- Hats must be maroon school hats with logo available from school office or uniform shop.
- Children without school hats will be told to remain seated in the shade (south of school building) during outside times.
- Children may be given written exercises to complete aimed at helping them to remember to bring their hat.

SUNSCREEN POLICY

- As some children have allergies to some sunscreens, we ask that each family be responsible for their own children's sunscreen needs.
